To this end SSE, who will be MC's delivery partner for the works, would like to meet with local businesses to offer them the opportunity to be involved in the development and delivery of works on multiple MC properties, including iconic buildings like Gun Wharf, Brook Theatre, Medway Park Leisure Centre and more. The works are aimed at making the buildings more energy efficient and environmentally friendly, helping to reduce CO2 emissions and improve the local environment and will include projects such as:

- Solar Panel Installation
- Air conditioning & heating systems
- Low carbon heating
- Electrical works
- Lighting
- Plumbing works
