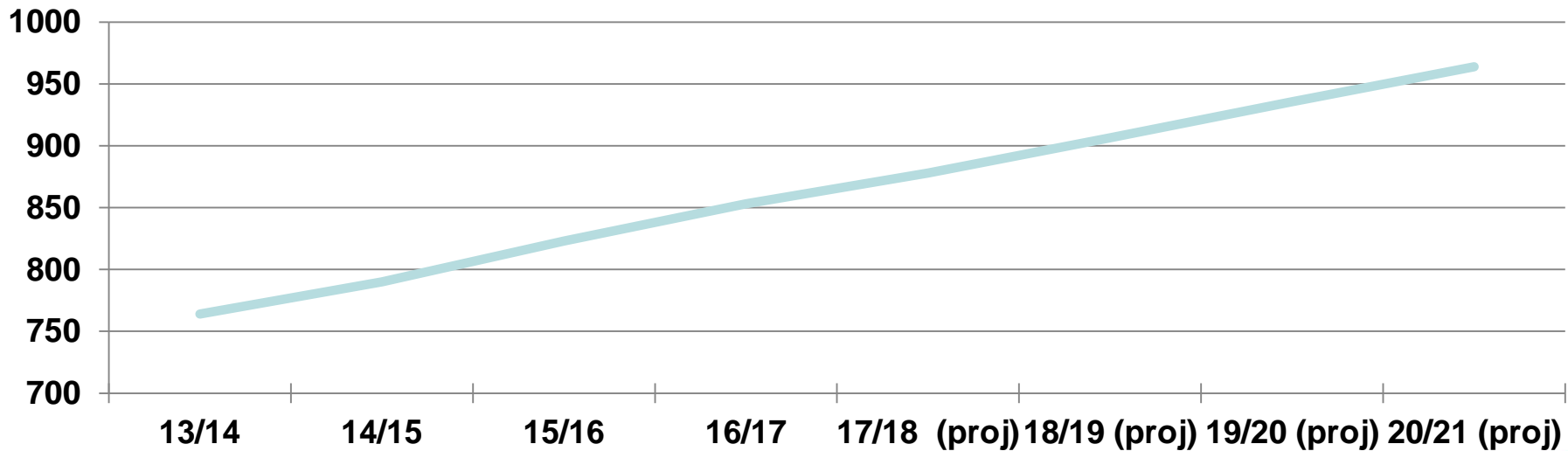
# Welcome to Enfield

- **5<sup>th</sup> largest borough in London**
- **At Mid-2016 the population was estimated to be 331,395**
- **870+ adults with LD supported by Social Services**
- **31% increase between 2011 - 2017**
- **Increasing numbers of people with behaviour that challenges**
- **Highest number of people living in settled accommodation in the community in London**
- **4 special secondary schools**
- **One of the lowest numbers of people in residential out of borough placements**
- **Only 1 person in hospital under the Transforming Care Programme**
- **Robust partnership working between health, social care and VCS.**

<b>Moderate to severe learning disabilities</b>	<p>An individual who has a learning disability</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- but may be able to travel on his/her own or with minimum support;</li> <li>- access college, volunteering or meaningful work activities</li> <li>- may needs support with daily tasks such as budgeting, cleaning, cooking</li> <li>- may have difficulties with social skills</li> </ul>	<b>Lot 1a</b>	<b>Lot 1b</b>
<b>Profound and multiple learning disabilities and /or complex health needs</b>	<p>An individual who has a learning disability and</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- difficulties communicating</li> <li>- additional sensory needs (visual / hearing impairment)</li> <li>- physical disabilities, such as cerebral palsy</li> <li>- complex health needs</li> <li>- mental health difficulties</li> <li>- difficulties with movement and posture control</li> <li>- some people may have epilepsy</li> <li>- may require oxygen, tube feeding or suctioning equipment</li> </ul> <p>(Mencap PMLD factsheet about profound and multiple learning disabilities)</p>	<b>Lot 2a</b>	<b>Lot 2b</b>
<b>Learning disabilities and behaviour that challenges and/or mental health issues</b>	<p>An individual who has a learning disability and</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- behaviour that challenges which may include self-injury, hurting others, destructive behaviour, etc.</li> <li>- have autism</li> <li>- have little or no speech</li> <li>- need support with daily activities such as dressing, washing eating and keeping safe</li> </ul> <p>(The Challenging Behaviour Foundation)</p>	<b>Lot 3a</b>	<b>Lot 3b</b>
