Background Information:

Cumbria County Council would like to engage with existing and potential service providers to discuss the future delivery of Targeted Short Break Activities for children with disabilities.

Targeted Activities:

- can be accessed without needing to have a formal assessment
- take place outside of school hours
- allow families with children who are disabled to have a break from their caring responsibilities
- are an early help service that aims to promote and support family wellbeing and resilience

Examples of Targeted Activities:

- Regular after school clubs for young people to meet & socialise
- Weekend clubs sport, craft and activity clubs
- School holiday breaks one off day trips, adventure activities or regular clubs during holidays
- Family fun days inclusive activities for disabled young people and their whole family
