## Invitation to Tender Decoration of Communal Areas, Bridge Buildings, Bideford



You are invited to tender for the general internal decoration of the communal areas within Bridge Buildings, including the main stairwell and associated lobbies on each floor, staff toilets and the staff Kitchen.

The works involve the following:

- 1. Repairs to sections of penetrative damp damaged plaster.
- 2. The general preparation and redecoration of walls and ceilings within areas specified.
- 3. The general preparation and redecoration of skirtings, doors, door frames, window frames and sills, handrails, balustrades, newel posts, frames to glass screens etc, within areas specified.
- 4. The replacement of areas of carpet within the main stairwell and one office.
- 5. The replacement of old vinyl sheeting in a number of staff WC's.
- 6. The replacement of damaged ceramic tiles forming 'splash backs' to hand basins in a number of Staff WC's.
- 7. New shower enclosures to the two existing shower trays within the first floor WC's, including fitting Wet Board to the exposed external walls.
- 8. Final general clean of areas specified

It is anticipated that the contract period will be 4 weeks with works programmed to be started no later than Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2011 and completed by Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2011. It will be necessary for an amount of the works to be undertaken out of normal office hours (after 5pm or over the weekend) due to the busy nature of the stairwell.

The successful tenderer will be selected on 'value for money' principles, on the basis of 60% Price, 40% Quality.

Quality will be assessed through:

1. A supporting statement (One to two sides of A4 outlining the Contractors experience of similar type and size schemes e.g., listed building, office use)

2. A program for the proposed works

3. A method statement to demonstrate how works are going to be undertaken, taking into account the busy office nature of the building.
