
Digital Innovation Dynamic Purchasing System



Strategic context

The <u>Dorset Council Plan</u> includes a Key Cabinet Commitment around Digital Innovation, pledging to: "Continue to pioneer new technologies and create the foundations for long-term economic prosperity. We will work to safeguard and encourage job retention and growth, working with the private sector."

This commitment underpins all five strategic priorities in the Council Plan, particularly our desire to drive economic prosperity.

How we will use the DPS

Projects such as the multi award-winning 5G RuralDorset project and Dorset Open Networks Ecosystem Project have earned us a reputation for world-class R&D supporting digital innovation.

We have developed an innovation ecosystem of local, national and international partners across public sector, academia, research and industry.

We aim to scale and diversify this ecosystem to achieve our strategic aims around economic growth and social opportunity. Creating a nationally significant innovation capability in sectors where we have strengths such as defence, security and agri-tech will, we believe, create additional inward investment.

A DPS is unlike a traditional framework for the supply of goods, works or services. It is an electronic system which suppliers can join at any time. An 'open market' solution, a DPS is designed to give buyers access to a pool of prequalified suppliers.

This DPS will allow the council to:

- Identify organisations looking to work with it/partners on digital innovation initiatives
- Make organisations aware of opportunities to work with the council and its digital innovation partners
- Publish details of services and projects to allow organisations to compete for opportunities
- Contract with organisations in an open and transparent way which meets procurement regulations and supports the council's strategic aims above
- Grow the Dorset innovation ecosystem



Scope of requirements

The individual requirements published via the DPS could cover anything classed as digital innovation products and services. It could, for example, cover hardware, software and "as a service" solutions.
