S 1205 Restrictions or requirements for subcontracting

The *Client's* requirements regarding the amount of work being undertaken by Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs), in the Local Area is defined in the Invitation to Submit an Initial Tender (ISIT), in the Social Value section.

The *Contractor* will supply to the *Service Manager*, on an annual basis, the information that is required to be reported in the Social Value section of the Invitation to Submit an Initial Tender (ISIT).

For the purposes Scope S 1205, the Local Area is defined as within the administrative area of the *Client*.

S 1210 Acceptance procedures

On the 1st March each year, the *Contractor* submits the name of each proposed Subcontractor to the *Service Manager* for acceptance. The *Service Manager* may not accept the Subcontractor in accordance with Clause 24 of the Conditions of Contract.

The Contractor submits the name of any additional Subcontractor proposed after the 1st March each year to the *Service Manager* for acceptance. The *Service Manager* may not accept the Subcontractor in accordance with Clause 24 of the Conditions of Contract.

The Contractor will update the list of accepted Subcontractors on the *Client's* Share Point site, whenever a change is made.
