3 Presentation Requirements – Lot Two C

The applicants will be required to provide a response which covers the following two scenarios:

Scenario one

One Young Parent placed at your service is not engaging with universal services; their individual key working/ support sessions or with any other professionals or services offering them and their baby support. The Young Parent has also been displaying very low mood and has been struggling looking after themselves, caring for their four month old baby, managing their money and keeping their accommodation clean

What are the identified concerns and how will you address the issues to support and help the Young Parent

Scenario two

A Young Parent has started a new relationship with someone she met a month ago and has advised she is going to find somewhere for them all to live. No one in your service has met this person or know anything about him. The Young Parent is not willing to tell you anything about him apart from she met him at a local park. The Young Parent is a Care leaver who experienced considerable trauma in her childhood and she has a mild Learning disability.

Please advise what concerns you have and what steps you would take and why
