As part of its One Government initiative (https://www.gov.je/Government/NewStatesStructure/Pages/ AboutNewStatesStructure.aspx) and its aim to operate as an effective and efficient organisation, GoJ is looking to join up its administrative staff in a single administrative headquarter of approximately 11,000 sq m NIA in Central St Helier. This project should promote better teamwork and collaboration across functions and departments which is not currently being delivered through GoJ's existing office portfolio (36,000 sq m in 21 locations).

- 4. The project will support awareness, communication and engagement between colleagues in different departments and promote health and well-being of the people who work there and contribute to the GoJ being an attractive place to work.
- 5. The project should promote the social effectiveness of St Helier and, in particular, the areas surrounding the site on which the office is to be located (which is not yet determined).

Following market consultation, GoJ expects to commence the procurement process in February 2020 with a preferred bidder being awarded a contract by October 2020.
