YRCT Schemes:

- Horsey Lane, Police Station (which is to be redeveloped), Preston Brook. Note Millbrook
 residents are concerned of land being raised opposite Bradfords.
 With regard to the Police Station re-development and SuDs opportunities Lorne has spoken
 to a Karen Westlake Properties Manager and Paul Tovell Project Manager at Police HQs
 Portishead to establish what they are doing and their provision for attenuation.
- Pen Mill Trading Estate, railway station (initial engagement with Network Rail was positive), Fiveways School, Camborne Road & Camborne Grove (WW may be interested).
 - Pollution issues in relation to gullies on trading estate Lorne has contacted AHO.
 - Buckland Road (off trading estate) investigation to be carried out by Lorne.
- Millfield Valley to Milford dip SSDC working with YRCT with an estimated cost of £58k. Small scale modified kerbs, modify highway drainage & swales etc.. Attenuation pond to the rear of the playing field opposite Melrose Road.
- Elizabeth flats (Yarlington), Highfield Road, Charlstone Avenue opportunity for SuDs & flood alleviation
- Westfield estate & Westfield Academy
- Preston Academy on hold due to discussions with ongoing maintenance responsibilities (note: academy may be looking to sell-off some land for development further muddying the waters.
