### Description of Services:

The Youth Service aims to provide a wide range of high-quality engaging opportunities and activities for young people aged 11-19 (up to age 25 if they have additional needs) to enable them to build their social and emotional skills, develop their own projects and enjoy safe spaces.

The provision will be divided:

- **LOTS 1 SPECIALIST PROJECTS** aimed at groups of young people that may require dedicated support. There are 4 sublots.

- **LOT 2 DETACHED TEAMS** that will undertake street-based youth work with hard to reach groups of young people; The lot will cover: North East Quadrant; North East Quadrant; South East Quadrant; South East Quadrant; and Borough Central. **Estimated annual value £295,000**

### Additional Information:
