Directions to City Library

Arriving by rail

The City Library is within easy walking distance of Newcastle Central Station or you can take the Metro one stop to Monument Metro Station.

To walk from Central Station leave the main entrance and cross Neville Street using the pedestrian crossing. Turn right and walk a few metres to the first road on the left. Turn up Grainger Street and walk straight ahead for 500 metres towards Grey's Monument, a column standing at the junction of Grainger Street, Grey Street and Blacket Street. Turn right at Grey's Monument onto Blacket Street and the Library is visible 200m straight ahead.

Walking from Monument Metro Station

The City Library is two minutes walk from Monument Metro Station. Leave the metro station via the Blacket Street exit and the City Library is visible 200m straight ahead. Walk along Blacket Street to the junction with the pedestrianised Northumberland Street. Either continue straight ahead along New Bridge Street West and enter the library via the blue glass entrance on level 1, or turn left along Northumberland Street for 20 metres and then turn right up Northumberland Place to enter the library via the Princess Square entrance on level 2.

Arriving by road

Follow signs to the city centre and the central motorway A167(M).

From the south cross the river over the Tyne Bridge A167 and then take the second slip road off the central motorway. At the roundabout take the second exit onto Durant Road.

From the north and west head towards the city centre along the A167. After passing the junction with the B1318 take the second exit off the central motorway. At the roundabout take the forth exit onto Durant Road. Drive to the T-junction with John Dobson Street. Turn right at the traffic lights then immediately left into the John Dobson Street NCP, or left and then right at the traffic lights beside the City Library to enter the New Bridge Street West NCP.

There are also blue badge bays on John Dobson Street directly outside the City Library and on North Street between the John Dobson Street NCP and the Library.
