Statutory Requirements

- The service is a requirement for Local Authorities under the 1989 Children's Act (Section 24)
- The successful supplier will need to deliver the service in accordance with the National Standards for the Provision of Children's Advocacy Services and best practice, and will include an Independent Visitors service.
- The standards are informed by Article 12 of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and the Human Rights Act 1998.





Service details

- The main aims of the service are to:
- Ensure that the views of children and young people are heard when decisions are being made that affect them.
- Help children and young people to access services from all the agencies they are involved with
- Help children and young people understand and exercise their rights and stay safe.
- Provide advice and support to children and young people
- Offer independent friendly support where contact with parents is infrequent or has stopped.





Service Details

The service will need to cover the following:

- Children's Rights and Advocacy
- Independent Visitors
- Independent Child Protection Advocacy
- Residential Visiting Advocacy
